SUBJECT: COWG COVID-19 | Remobilization Update

1. Below is an update to the counties that are in a “Level Red” status by the Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment (CDPHE) or as determined by local health orders.

a. Pitkin County as of 17JAN20201

2. Level Red status restricts all indoor activities, regardless of the size of the gathering. Squadrons operating in a County that is considered “Level Red” must cease indoor meetings and indoor activities. During Level Red status, single-pilot proficiency flying is allowed along with mission critical activities to include A9 maintenance sorties, annual F5 and F91 check ride renewals, and real-world operational missions.

3. Effective 15 January 2021 Colorado Wing will resume Phase 2 remobilization – modified. Under Phase 2 remobilization squadrons may resume indoor weekly squadron meetings and activities. Phase 2 modified will restrict capacity of indoor and outdoor meetings to 50 members.

4. Pilot training and proficiency flying, flight training and evaluations, cadet flight training may resume with 1 – 2 members. Cadet orientation flights – with 1 cadet (unless same family) may resume.

5. High risk personnel should exercise caution with resuming in person meetings. Be cautious of putting all qualified personnel in one location including pilots. Continue to social distance, wear masks, do health checks, record meeting attendance, and sanitize.

6. Exceptions for meeting / activity attendance restrictions should be routed to COWG/CC. Exceptions for flights should be routed to COWG/DO.
